

The St Andrew's at Rangi Ruru Organ Scholarship Grant for 2025

The St Andrew's at Rangi Ruru Organ Scholarship Grant is awarded annually as a result of a generous scholarship offered by the St Andrew's at Rangi Ruru Parish.

The scholarship grant provides for weekly organ lessons as part of the ITM programme. The value of the scholarship grant is \$1,500 per annum, shared between successful applicants as necessary. If the grant is shared it will mean that parents will be expected to pay for any lessons not covered by their daughter's share of the grant. The cost per 30-minute lesson in 2025 will be \$39.00. If awarded to only one student, the scholarship grant will cover the full cost of all organ lessons for 2025.

The conditions of the scholarship grant are as follows:

Will be awarded to a student who -

- a) is a current Rangi Ruru student from Year 9 and above.
- b) is a competent pianist to at least Grade 5 level and who shows musical promise.

Notes:

- i) The recipient must demonstrate that they have good work/practice habits and must be able to commit to attending lessons on a regular basis, and regular practice, on the Church organ, between lessons.
- ii) The scholarship grant may be re-awarded.
- iii) As this scholarship grant has been provided through the generosity of the St Andrew's at Rangi Ruru Parish the recipient may, once they are able, be asked to play at an occasional Sunday service, in addition to helping out with some school services.
- iv) The scholarship grant may be awarded to a student currently holding a Rangi Ruru Music Scholarship.
- v) Short listed applicants may be required for an interview and/or audition.
- vi) The decision of the award is the prerogative of the Principal after consultation with the Director of Music.
